Stamp Out Mailbox Fishing!

If you're mailing checks, money orders, or tax returns, protect yourself from mailbox fishing and check fraud:

- Drop mail containing checks inside the post office to ensure that your mail is not stolen from a mailbox.
- When writing checks, use permanent ink that cannot be erased.
- Check your account balance frequently to ensure that the proper amount is debited.
- If you see anyone tampering with a mailbox, report it immediately to 911.





The Scam:

Beware of door-to-door roofing scammers who may be impersonating a certified contractor. If they don't find pre-existing wear and tear, they may intentionally cause damage to your roof in order to defraud you.

How to avoid roofing scams:

- · Beware of unsolicited offers.
- · Avoid uninvited contractors.
- Don't make an immediate decision.
- Verify legitimacy of roofing company by calling 311.
- Research roofing companies and get multiple estimates before you hire.
- · Immediately report any suspicious activity to the NYPD by calling 911.

A person or a business must have a Home Improvement Contractor License to do construction, repair, remodeling, or other home improvement work to any residential land or building in NYC. For more information dial 311 to contact the NYC Department of Consumer and Worker Protection.
