## Working Group II April 12, 2019

Working Group II was mandated by the motion passed by the National Board members, on October of 2016, 'to determine the feasibility of forming, chartering, funding and/or empowerment of a new veterans' organization to perpetuate our legacy and assure the tomorrow of all veterans which will be communicated to the general membership for approval at a convention.'

Since 2005, VVA has been dealing with the future of VVA.

We are not morphing into another organization or starting a new veteran service organization. We will cease to exist and a new veteran service organization may begin to address the future of all veterans.

## **Trust the Process:**

The following is the process that Working Group II undertook - **N.A.T.O.** 

- N Nature why we are meeting and the intent which was to make decisions, share information, to solve problems, to brainstorm ideas;
- A Agenda-what will be done, who will do it, when will it be done, how & when will we stop;
- T -Time-establish the amount of time that will be devoted to the meetings;
- **O** Outcomes-knowing our roles, the rules, and responsibilities leading to a documented action plan.

## The seven implementation steps were followed and is in the handouts.

Working Group II employed the **S.W.O.T** review of VVA's Mission, Vision & Values in our planning:

- **S** Strengths: what practices are really working well, organizational competencies, effective process;
- W Weaknesses: knowledge gaps, inefficient procedures, lack of value, synergy;
- ${\bf O}-{\rm Opportunities:}\ untapped\ resources,\ positive\ changes\ in\ external\ environment;$
- T Threats: environmental changes, threatened resources, unwise practices.

The Conclusion: It is feasible to form a new veterans' organization!

Working Group II makes a recommendation to the National Board to form a committee to pursue the necessary requirements for the creation of a new veteran service organization to assure the tomorrow of all veterans.

This would insure that the continuation of our Founding Principle of "Never Again Will One Generation of Veterans Abandon Another."
