


## Frank Brown, 66

STATEN ISLAND, N.Y. — Frank J. Brown, 66, a U.S. Army veteran and retired truck driver, died yesterday in Staten Island University Hospital, Ocean Breeze.

Born in Brooklyn, Mr. Brown graduated from Lafayette High School and moved to Dongan Hills in 1983.

He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War and was honored with the Bronze Star.

Mr. Brown worked as a truck driver for 24 years, retiring in 2000.

He was a Boy Scout leader for many years and a member of the Vietnam Veterans

Organization; Catholic War Veterans of America; American Legion, and the Veterans of Foreign War.

He was a parishioner of St. Ann's R.C. Church, Dongan Hills.

In his leisure time, he enjoyed woodworking, sports and swimming.

"He was a good father and husband," said wife of 34 years, the former Constance D'Ambrosio.

In addition to his wife, Constance, surviving are two sons, Frank and Justin; two brothers, Charles and James, and a sister, Nancy Russo.

The funeral will be Saturday from the Casey Funeral Home, Castleton Corners, with a mass at 9:30 a.m. in St. Ann's Church. Burial will follow in Ocean View Cemetery, Oakwood.
